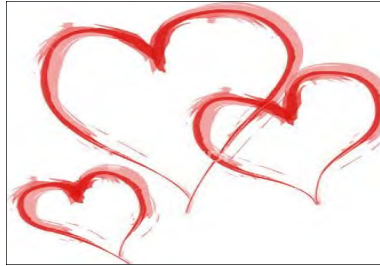
Box Tops for Education

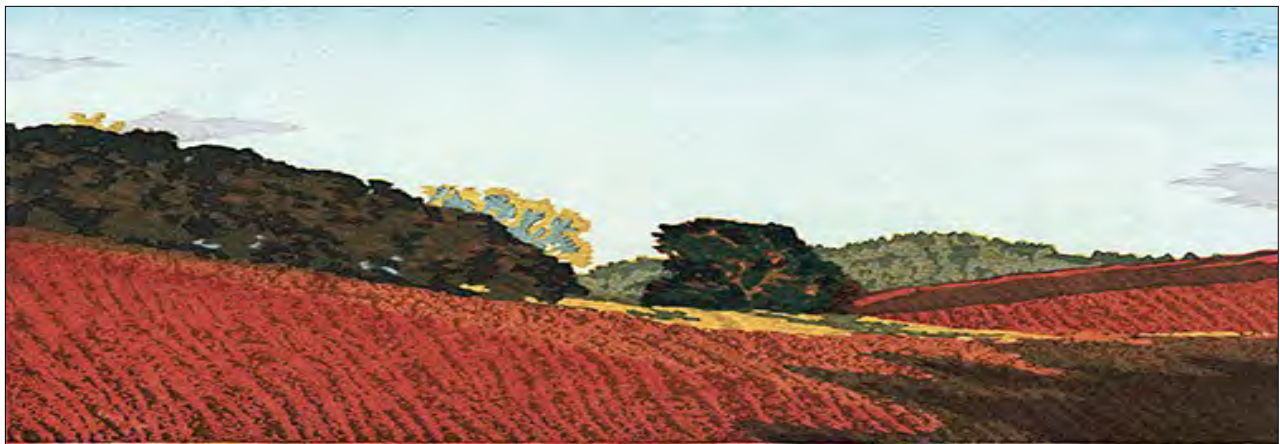

Monday - Meatball Sandwiches

One of our favorite sandwiches, this hearty meatball sub comes on freshly baked hoagie rolls, donated by Sonoma County's own Village Bakery! Homemade Marinara sauce with a bounty of vegetables (The kids don't realize how many veggies they're eating!!!) and provolone cheese round out this savory sandwich.

Tuesday - Taco Bar

Taco Tuesday this week will have shredded chicken (w/ a garlic-citrus marinade), red rice, and pinto beans. As always, our taco bar comes complete with: salsa, "sour cream" (plain greek yogurt), cilantro, and other taco toppings. It's a fiesta for your tastebuds!

Wednesday - Fried Rice Bowl

Ginger, Garlic, and Scallions give this take-out favorite it's familiar flavor. Paired with a roasted pork tenderloin (brined in orange, garlic, soy, & brown sugar) The only thing missing is the fortune cookie!

Thursday - Hot Dogs & Corn Salad

Turkey franks are not only delicious, they're also better for you! Classic toppings will include: ketchup, mustard, relish, and chopped onions. The fresh roasted corn salad this week will include cherry tomatoes from Mrs. Wolfe's home garden! Loaded with flavors of the southwest, like fresh cilantro, sweet red onion, and lime juice make for a perfect side!

Friday - Pesto Pasta & 3-Bean Salad

A Genovese favorite, our pesto is always nut-free, and classic in flavor. Al dente pasta is tossed with the pesto and served alongside a 3-Bean salad with a light vinaigrette.
