What's Cookin'

In the Kenwood Café

For the week of October 9th:



Monday - Chicken Parmesan Sandwiches

Hand breaded chicken, coated in fresh marinara. Homemade Marinara sauce with a bounty of vegetables (The kids don't realize how many veggies they're eating!!!) and provolone cheese round out this savory sandwich.

Tuesday - Chicken Tortilla Soup

Wednesday - Chicken Katsu

Chicken Katsu is a Japanese dish also popular in Hawaii. The chicken is hand breaded and baked for the students (rather than deep fried). Served with steamed rice and an optional sweet and savory sauce.

Thursday - Pizza Day w/fruit salad

Friday - Vegetarian Chili and cornbread

What does our salad bar offer everyday...

- Greens, two options daily. Romaine is a constant staple, and our second option rotates between spring mix and fresh spinach. Our lovely school garden provides us with mixed greens when in season as well.
- 3 standard toppings: cucumbers, cherry tomatoes, and shredded carrots.
- 6 rotating toppings (common options): red pepper hummus, bell peppers, baby carrots, celery, artichoke hearts, broccoli, kidney beans, corn, and beets.
- Cranberries and Sunflower seeds
- Fresh whole and sliced fruit
- Salad dressings: Ranch (made with greek yogurt instead of mayo), sesame ginger, and balsamic. We also offer oil & vinegar.

Did you know? -Adults are always welcome to dine with their student (\$3.50 Child, \$4.00 Adult). All we ask is that you sign up with the office in the morning of your visit, and get a visitors pass. Come see how school lunches *should* be!

Kindergarteners, although they don't stay for school lunch until November 27th, you and your student are welcome to join us for lunch at 12 o'clock if you stay after class! **Sign up** in the office when dropping off your student in the morning, so the kitchen can accurately prepare for each guest.

As always, our menu items have a **vegetarian** option available.
