



HOLIDAY BOUTIQUE HOW-TO SELL

Step 1: MAKE IT!

Create your craft (parental guidance and some help is perfectly acceptable), and package it if needed. Please- **NO** items that resemble **weapons** of any kind, **NO** immediate **perishable** gifts like cupcakes, cookies, candy, breads, etc. Aim for making items like baking mixes, hot cocoa mixes, meat rubs, cat or dog treats or the likes instead. All food items **MUST HAVE** a list of ingredients and a **USE BY** date. Any items that do not follow these rules have to be turned away!

Step 2: TAG IT!

Cut your pre-printed tags, write your name & grade on one the left, and your name and price on the right. Attach it securely to your craft. You can print more tags by going to our website, <http://kenwoodschoolassociation.com>

Step 3: LIST IT!

Fill out the inventory list so we know everything you have made and given us to sell for you.

Step 4: CHECK IT by Monday 12/4

Bring everything to school on Friday, December 1st or Monday, December 4th and check them in at the school library.
