AFTER SCHOOL SPANISH CLASS

I am pleased to announce that we will be continuing with our after school Spanish class for students in grades 1-3. The class, which will begin on Tuesday, April 9th, will again be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:15-3:50. Mrs. Morrissey (our 6th grade teacher and formerly our Spanish teacher) will again be teaching this. Continuing students and “new” students are both welcome to attend. The class will meet 8 times, with the final meeting on Thursday, May 2nd.

If you are interested in signing your child up for this after school course, please return the attached form to our office by Monday, April 8th. The cost of the class will be \$80 per child for the entire session. We understand that our primary grade students are dismissed at 2:30 on the scheduled class sessions. Parents who will be in need of childcare for the period from 2:30-3:15 are welcome to contract with our after school “Cougar Club” for this period of time, as well as for the time following the class at 3:50. Please contact Jennifer Stenerson, our Cougar Club/Preschool office manager (833-6551) with any questions regarding the Cougar Club. Mrs. Morrissey will be escorting all students who are enrolled in the class from the Cougar Club to the classroom and back to Cougar Club at the conclusion of the class.
