Dear Parents,

I would like to inform all of our families that the Kenwood School District Board of Trustees passed a resolution at last week's meeting to "formally" extend our distance learning period through December 31, 2020. While this is not an unexpected decision, it does keep us focused on the fact that the distance learning format will continue through the end of the calendar year. For those of you with children at the middle school and high school levels, this decision mirrors the decision made by Santa Rosa City Schools to continue with distance learning through the same period of time.

Kenwood School will be having a school "picture day" for all students through coordination with the Lifetouch company. We are discussing calendar dates with Lifetouch and will share this date with you as soon as we have it confirmed. We envision "picture day" to be held in the multi-purpose room (as usual) with students entering (socially distanced) through the staff parking lot/basketball court area to avoid congestion on campus and to allow for a quick entrance and exit for all students and families.

Please remember that we will "celebrate" Halloween on Friday, October 30 during our "pick up and drop off" hours of 1-3. Students are welcome to wear costumes and to step outside of their car for photo opportunities for teachers and/or parents.


