## **Kindergarten Registration for 2021 – 2022 School Year**

For registration information, please contact Suzanne Borgert in the school office at 833-2500. Kindergarten registration is open to children who turn five on or before September 1, 2021. Parents must provide proof that they are a Kenwood resident.

Transitional Kindergarten registration is open to children who reside within the Kenwood School District boundaries and whose fifth birthday is between September 2 and December 2, 2021.

If you reside outside of the Kenwood School District boundaries, you will need to file a District of Choice Transfer Form with the Kenwood School office by December 31, 2020.

### **Grade 6 Parent Information:**

Registration for resident families for RVMS and any school in the Santa Rosa City School District begins in January. The process is the same as last year where families will register online. Please note the link is NOT live yet for the 21/22 school year.

- Due to COVID restrictions, we will not be holding a Showcase Night on our campus for incoming 7th and 8th grade families. In lieu of Showcase, we will be posting a slideshow and videos highlighting RVMS to help families learn more about us on our school website. We hope to have this material up on our website in January. We encourage families to check our website for information or reach out to us directly for questions.
