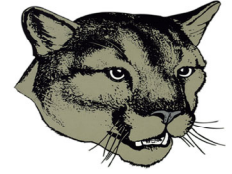


Kenwood School Return to School Guide for Parents

Arrival:

- **All students will arrive on their designated cohort day at the front main entrance of the school at their designated arrival times.** Social distancing will be emphasized and reinforced.
- Classroom assistants will be greeting students arriving in cars to ask health screening questions, taking temperatures, and directing students to their classrooms.
- **Students in grades 1-3** will proceed to the main entrance of the school.
- **Kindergarten** parents will drop their child off at the gate to the kindergarten play area.
- **Parents of students in grades 4-6** will be asked to proceed to the parking lot on Randolph Avenue to drop off their children.
- **Preschool** families will drop their child off by the preschool gate.
- Classroom teachers will remain in their classrooms to meet students as they arrive.

Departure:

- Students will be escorted by their teachers to the **front of the school for preschool and grades K-3**, and on Randolph Avenue by the parking lot for students in **grades 4-6**.
