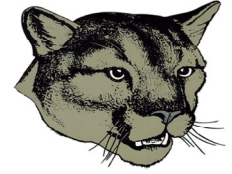


Kenwood School Newsletter

Rainbow Garden is a preschool program dedicated to creating a fertile, magical place full of nurturing and light, where kids can get messy, use their imaginations, become great problem solvers, express themselves, have fun and get excited about coming to school! Days at Rainbow Garden are rich with song and joyful exploration.

Curriculum includes:

- ☀ Wonderful open-ended art and tactile activities

- ☀ Hands-on exploration of science, math and language

Structure and flexibility combine to create an environment which responds to what is currently fascinating the children – from worms to dinosaurs to ice on puddles!

Teacher Jill Dawson has spent nearly 30 years working with children. She has B.A. degrees in both Early Childhood Education and Community Health Education. In 1996 she won the Center Child Care Professional Award of Sonoma County. As the former Owner/Director of parent participation preschools in Santa Rosa and Glen Ellen, and as a parent herself, Jill has a special appreciation for parents' challenges as well as their talents. In addition to preschool she has taught music, outdoor education, and art. She loves really getting to know each child and to support their interests in spontaneous and creative ways! She loves her job.

MORE INFO:

- ☀ Maximum of 15 children (with an aide) ages 2 yrs, 9 mo. (potty trained) – 5 yrs. A low adult/child ratio allows for a nurturing and individually supportive environment.
- ☀ Part-time program (8:15- 2:15) Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday. Wednesday (8:15- 1:15)
- ☀ Affiliation with Kenwood Elementary School
- ☀ Cost: \$49/day Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday. \$42 on Wednesday. There is an annual \$95 registration fee. Two hours of parent participation or an additional \$25 monthly (there are many ways to help). Kids bring their own healthy food for snack & lunches.
