## Kindergarten Registration for 2023– 2024 School Year

For registration information, please contact Suzanne Borgert in the school office at (707) 833-2500. Kindergarten registration is open to children who turn five on or before September 1, 2023. Parents must provide proof that they are a Kenwood resident.

Transitional Kindergarten registration is open to children who reside within the Kenwood School District boundaries and whose fifth birthday is between September 2 and April 2, 2024.

If you reside outside of the Kenwood School District boundaries, you will need to file a District of Choice Transfer Form with the Kenwood School office by January 1, 2023.

### **Supervisor Susan Gorin Invites District 1 Constituents to Serve on the Springs Municipal Advisory Council, North Sonoma Valley Municipal Advisory Council, Additional Committees, Commissions, and Boards.**

**SANTA ROSA, CA.** – In the First District, Supervisor Susan Gorin is currently calling for applicants for the Springs Municipal Advisory Council (Springs MAC), the North Sonoma Valley Municipal Advisory Council (North Sonoma Valley MAC), and additional committees, commissions, and boards.

“The Springs MAC, North Sonoma Valley MAC, and our other committees, commissions, and boards provide important links between county government and residents of the First District,” said Supervisor Susan Gorin. “Please consider applying to join a committee, and let your voice be heard.”

**Springs Municipal Advisory Council (Springs MAC):** The Springs MAC will represent the best interests of the entire community while acting as a bridge for communication between the County and local residents and businesses on topics for the Springs Area. Ideal candidates will create a diverse composition representative of the Spring MAC community. Members must reside or work within the boundaries of the Municipal Advisory Council, and be 18 years of age or older. There are no requirements for property ownership or citizenship.

**North Sonoma Valley Municipal Advisory Council (North Sonoma Valley MAC):** The North Sonoma Valley MAC serves the communities of Glen Ellen, Kenwood and Eldridge, and was approved by the Board of Supervisors on September 17th, 2019. The North Sonoma Valley MAC advises on issues of local concern, and provides a process to effectively communicate the needs of the community to County government and elected leaders. The MAC also serves to deliver information about the County government to the residents within the jurisdiction.

**Community Development Committee:** The Sonoma County Community Development Commission (CDC) is governed by the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors, acting as the Commissioners of the CDC. The Community Development Committee (Committee) acts as an advisory group to the Commissioners. The Committee reviews and makes recommendations on policy and funding matters to come before the Commission.

**Independent Office of Law Enforcement Review and Outreach Community Advisory Council (IOLERO CAC):** The purpose of the CAC is to serve as a bridge between law enforcement, IOLERO and various communities of the County. It also recommends possible changes to policies of the Sheriff's Office in order to better reflect the considered desires of the communities.
