Re: School Cell Phone/E-Device Restriction Guidelines

Dear Parents,

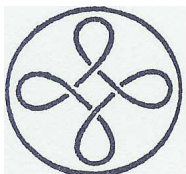
We hope this message finds you well. As we continue our efforts to maintain a focused and safe learning environment for all students, we want to inform you of an important update regarding student cell phones and other E-Devices such as iPads and Smartwatches on campus. As we start our new year dedicated to teaching and learning, we kindly ask that students do not bring cell phones or e-communication devices that can access incoming and outgoing calls or texts to school. Should you need to contact your child during the day, please contact the school office and we will relay the message to your child. If you feel your child needs to have access to their cell phone or electronic device for before and after school communication, the following guidelines are designed to minimize distractions during instructional time.

1. **Daily:** If your child absolutely needs to bring a cell phone to school for after-school communication or emergencies, they will be required to keep their phone in their backpack until school has been dismissed. Phones should be turned off to prevent classroom disruptions.
2. **No Cell Phones or Smartwatches During Class:** Students are not allowed to use cell phones during the school day. Smartwatches should be put into "School Mode" if available. Students caught using Cell Phones or Smartwatches (for non-curricular use) will have their devices placed in the office for retrieval at the end of the school day. Should a device be confiscated more than one time in a school year, the device will be kept in the office until a parent/guardian picks up the device.
3. **Emergency Use:** Students are permitted to use Cell Phones or Smartwatches during emergencies only.
4. **Parental Contact:** Parents are encouraged to contact their children through the school office rather than directly on their cell phones during school hours.
