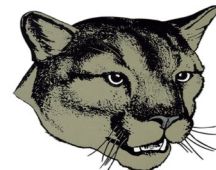
Attendance and being to school on time is incredibly important. It is difficult to explain just how missing only a few minutes, let alone a day of school affects a student's ability to be successful at school.

New Student Enrollment Procedures for the 2026-27 School Year

Enrollment timeline: December 1 – the last Friday in February (all forms must be received by the Kenwood School office).

Transitional Kindergarten - turns 4 years old on or before September 1, 2026.

Kindergarten - turns 5 years old on or before September 1, 2026.

2) For out of district residents, apply for an interdistrict transfer from your school district of residence to Kenwood School District.

* All applications must be received by February 27th. If necessary, a lottery will be held for out of district applicants, at our March Board of Trustees Meeting. You will be notified of your child's enrollment status after the March Board of Trustees Meeting.
