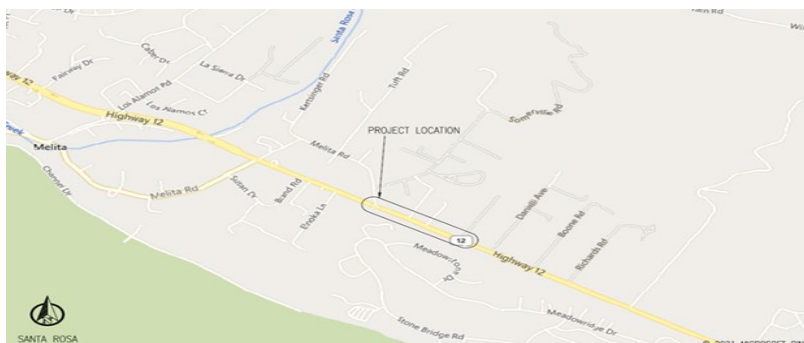
Subject: Traffic Advisory -- SR 12 Work Update from Sonoma County Board of Supervisors

We have heard many complaints about the backed up traffic last week on Highway 12 around the Oakmont area. We've communicated with CalTrans and PG&E, and CalTrans has switched the permit to night work. It will begin this week after the rains, and continue for a few days until the gas line replacement is complete. When it resumes, work will take place between 9pm and 6am.

Since Highway 12 is a state highway, the permit was issued between PG&E and CalTrans, and the County was not involved. However, we thank CalTrans for being responsive to the community complaints, and adjusting work times to prevent the terrible traffic we have seen over the past weeks. My office has communicated to CalTrans that night work is almost always preferable, though it is not without impact. This type of work is very loud, and doing the work overnight does impact neighbors to the project.

PG&E is enhancing the safety and reliability of the natural gas system in the area of Highway 12 and Melita Rd. This work involves removing legacy high pressure regulators to extend the current gas distribution system further down Highway 12. This is to connect customers in the area of 6191 Sonoma Highway onto the broader system, and the work also includes replacing old steel lines and installing 500 feet of new plastic distribution lines. Please note that, when the gas line replacement work is done, there will be a need for some day work which will impact traffic conditions once again. Paving cannot happen at night in the winter months, because ambient temperatures will likely be too cold for paving. Asphalt will not adhere at temperatures below 50-degrees Fahrenheit. We thank everyone for their patience while this project is completed.
